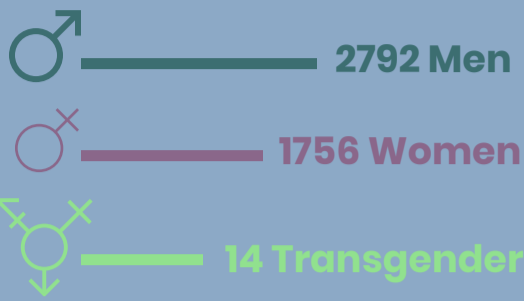

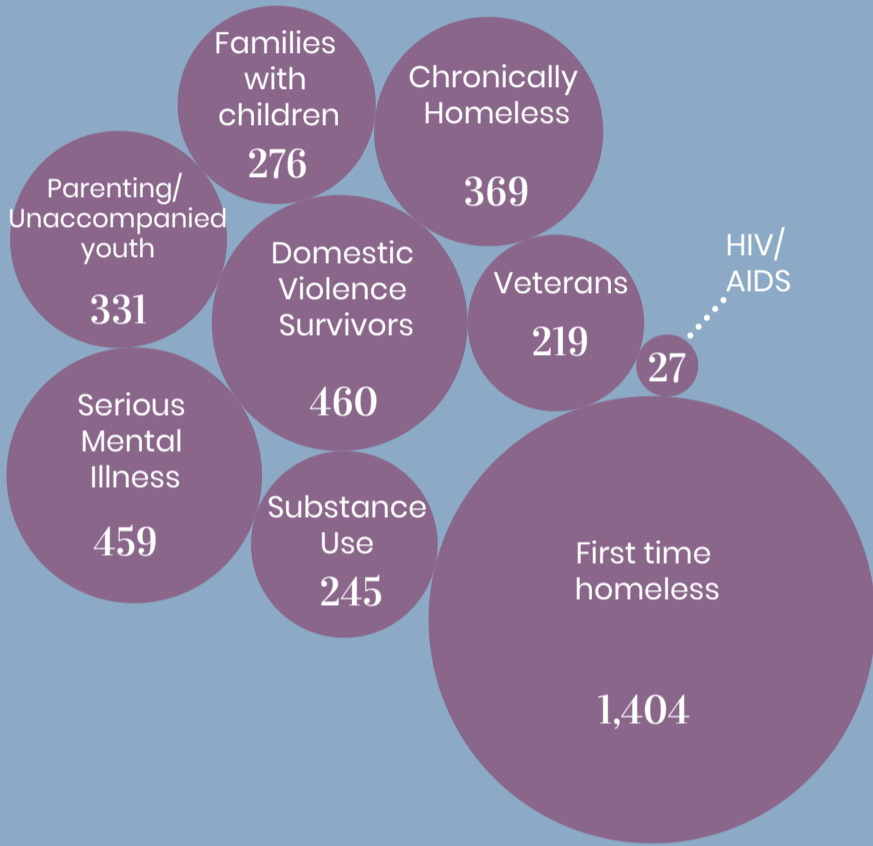

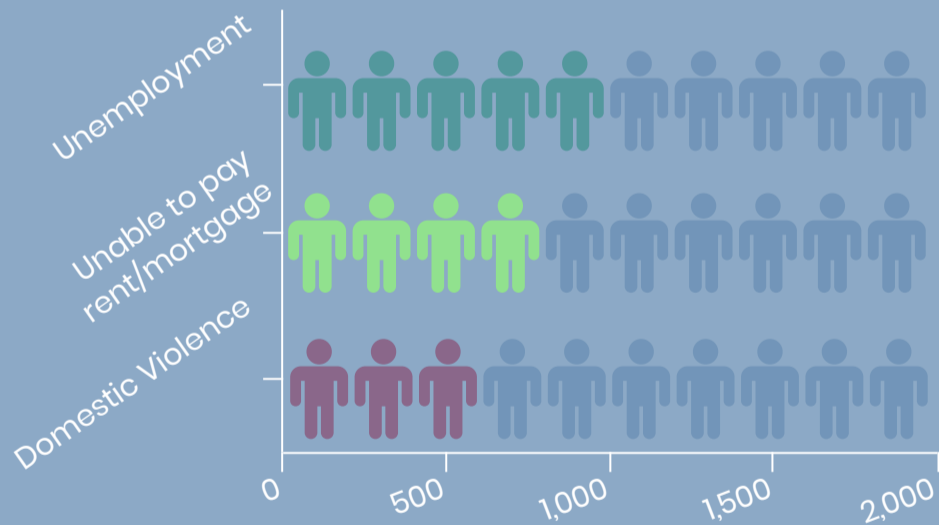

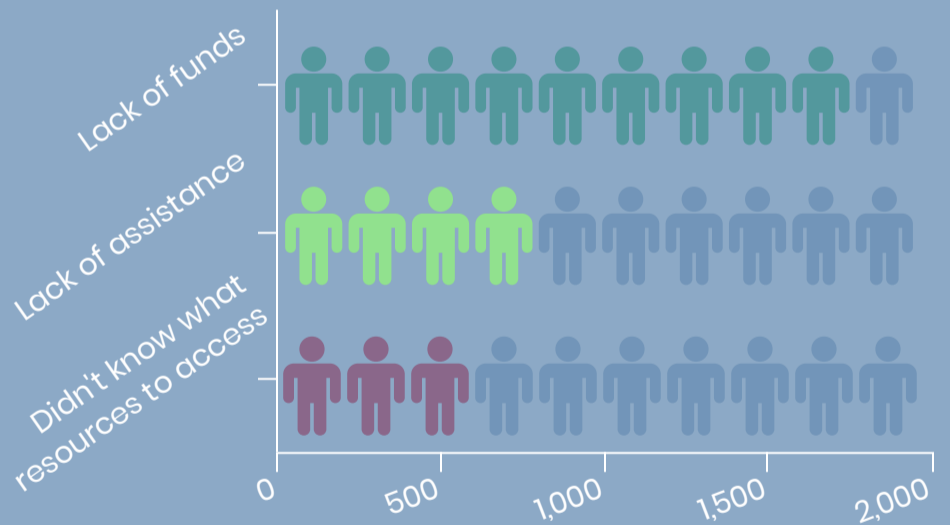

Top Three Reasons for Homelessness



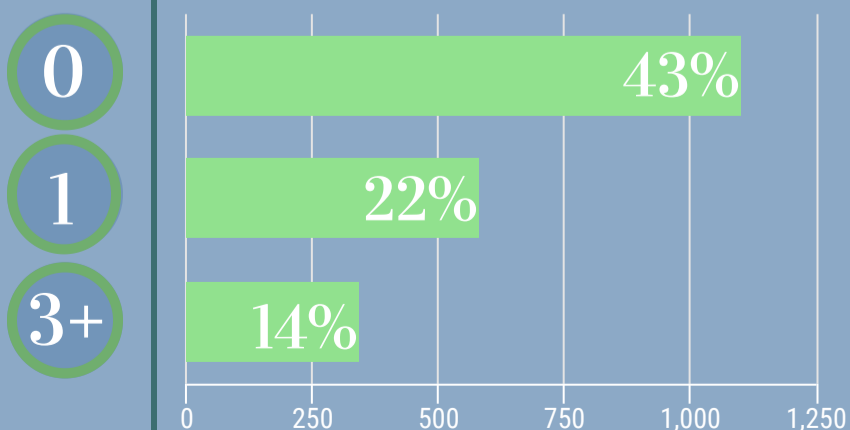
Top Three Barriers to Housing



ACES Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) is the term used to describe all types of abuse, neglect, and other potentially traumatic experiences that occur during childhood.



Number of ACEs



- 66% of individuals who have been in the criminal justice system reported they experienced at least 1 adverse childhood experience
- 68% of domestic violence survivors reported they had experienced at least 1 adverse childhood experience

* As the number of ACEs increases, so does the risk for chronic health conditions, unsafe behaviors, and shorter life expectancy.
