CoC Strategic Plan	Staff presented the Strategic Plan Quarter 3 Report; members had no questions	None

Point in Time Count (PIT Count)	Staff presented methodology for the upcoming 2023 PIT Count for the board's approval, as well as some updates. More hands-on training and office hours will be offered this year. No word from HUD on any considerations needing to be taken due to COVID-19. The board approved the methodology.	None

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Funding Opportunities	Staff presented a quick debrief on the results of the CoC Program Competition. The competition had a quicker timeline than usual, and was held at the same time as the new Supplemental Notice of Funding Opportunity to Address Unsheltered and Rural Homelessness (SNOFO), so the process was challenging. All projects eligible for it applied for renewal. Lots of interest in the DV bonus funding.	None
Supplemental Notice of Funding Opportunities to Address Unsheltered and Rural Homelessness (SNOFO)	Staff presented a brief update on the SNOFO. The application was challenging. It required unprecedented cross-sector collaboration, and because it is new, all applications must be ranked (no renewals). The input process required a lot of engagement with agencies and organizations within the CoC, and THN is considering a similar process for the CoC Program competition next year. There was strong engagement with Public Housing Authorities, and many PHA units were paired with RRH and PSH projects applying for SNOFO funding.	None
Emergency Housing Vouchers Program (EHV)	Staff discussed the new Stability Voucher program. These vouchers pair services with housing. They are non-competitive, and PHAs must work with CoC-affiliated organizations to receive them. TDHCA also has stability vouchers and has some set-aside for TX BoS CoC.	None
