


Our Mission



INTENTIONAL INCLUSION OF LIVED EXPERTISE



- Multiple avenues for people to share their experience, both good and bad
- Feedback is not an afterthought it is sought at every step
- Persons with Lived Experience are seen and respected as the experts

RECRUITMENT

- Run equity analysis prior to recruitment to ensure equitable outreach
- Create accessible and attractive marketing materials
- Ensured involvement and engagement through flexible pay structures and schedules







ENGAGEMENT

- Create a space of vulnerability and trust
 - Listening sessions with open ears for feedback
 - Engage in conversation outside of system-work
- Meet them where they are:
 - Libraries, different organizations, cooling or warming stations, etc.
 - Local schools, community colleges, and universities
- Communication is key!
 - Invite to all meetings (be willing to attend those as well)
 - Meet before meetings to explain background info and expectations





COMPENSATION



- Livable Wage (\$20/hour)
- Payment Options
- ACH/Direct Deposit
- Check
- Visa Gift Card
- Zelle, Cash App, Venmo





LESSONS LEARNED AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Honest feedback is possible when a safe space is created
- 2. Be prepared to make changes
- 3. The real experts are those who have experienced it
- 4. Coordination Matters: Communication, Transportation, Location
- 5. Dedicated staff capacity and funding must be a priority
