## **Adjacent Services**







#### Austin Resource Recovery (ARR) launched VKS in early 2020

- 100 bins
- Open 7:00am-10:00am and 3:00pm-7:00pm, Mon-Fri
- ARR staff supervision, 2 staff with lived experience

## DACC took over operations in December 2020

- Good fit for DACC's mission and values
- Continued partnership with ARR for staff and supplies
- Over time, increased to 350 bins
- Expanded hours to 7:00am7:00pm, 7 days per week
- DACC staff supervision, 6 staff with lived experience




