Public Comment Period for the CoC Governance Charter Is Open

The annual review of the CoC Governance Charter was held at the CoC General Membership Meeting on 9/27. One significant change to the Charter is being proposed: allowing the CoC Board, acting on behalf of the CoC, to approve proposed changes to the Charter. General Members would still have the opportunity to give input through the public comment process, and the CoC Board would continue to consider all comments submitted during public comment periods. This change would simplify the process for approving proposed changes to the Charter.

SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access and Recovery (SOAR) Informational Session

The Self-Help Homeownership Opportunity Program (SHOP) awards grant funds to eligible national and regional nonprofit organizations and consortia to purchase home sites and develop or improve the infrastructure needed to set the stage for sweat equity and volunteer-based homeownership programs for low-income persons and families. Through this Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), HUD is making \$13,500,000 of FY 2023 SHOP Program grant funds available to national and regional nonprofit organizations.
