Substantive proposed changes include:

- 1. **One Unified Document:** Combined four previously separate policies-Review and Scoring, Ranking, Conditional Inclusion, and Reallocation-into a single, streamlined TX BoS CoC Program Competition Policies document
- 2. Updated Review and Scoring Framework: Clarified application review and scoring policy for both Renewal and New Applicants
- 3. Enhanced Ranking Flexibility: Added language granting the Non-Conflicted Members of the CoC Board expanded discretion to rank new and renewal projects based on multi-year performance trends, strategic value, CoC priorities, and alignment with community needs
- **4.** Flexible Bonus Points Policy: Revised the Bonus Points section to allow annual adjustments based on HUD priorities, gaps analysis, and local needs
- 5. Refined Conditional Inclusion Process: Enhanced Conditional Inclusion section to include clearer criteria, discretionary authority, and more flexible Quality Review Plan (QRP) process for underperforming projects
- **6. Expanded Reallocation Procedures:** Expanded Reallocation section to include more refined procedures for involuntary reallocations, including additional strategic considerations and discretionary authority
