Welcome (Stephanie)	Meeting called to order at 3:05 PM by Chair, Stephanie. Quorum was met. Six members recused themselves, leaving 11 members; therefore, quorum was six (one more than half of 11).	
CoC Program (Billy)	Staff presented a Board Action Request (BAR) to consider reviewing the FY26 Ranking Scenario materials and selecting Scenario A, Scenario B, or Scenario C as the FY26 TX BoS CoC Priority Listing for inclusion in the CoC's FY26 CoC Program Consolidated Application to HUD and to authorize THN staff to make limited technical and administrative adjustments necessary to accurately implement the Board-selected scenario prior to final submission to HUD, including adjustments resulting from finalized Grant Inventory Worksheet (GIW) information, applicant budget revisions, applicant decisions regarding project transitions, HUD guidance, or other technical corrections that do not materially alter the scenario selected by the Board. Staff walked members through three ranking scenarios, each with various considerations. Members discussed the scenarios and asked questions that staff answered. Victor made a motion to approve Scenario B as the FY2026 TX BoS CoC Priority Listing for inclusion in the FY2026 CoC Program Consolidated Application to HUD and authorize THN staff to make any necessary technical and administrative adjustments that do not materially alter the Board-approved scenario prior to submission. Jason seconded the motion. Members voted. The motion passed. Next steps are that staff will notify applicants if their applications will be included in the Priority Listing or not. 8/11 is HUD's deadline to do that.	Motion passed.
